Downpour forces traffic to a standstill

KUALA LUMPUR: Traffic was brought to a standstill around the city centre yesterday morning as heavy rain forced motorists to slow down.

The downpour also caused a flash flood near the Sungai Rasau toll,

which resulted in a massive crawl in the Federal Highway.

Other areas that were affected included Subang Jaya, Kelana Jaya, Kajang Silk Highway, Kesas Highway, Shah Alam and here.

While the SMART Tunnel was not closed, traffic was also affected.

The Meteorological Department said the rains were brought on by the Southwest Monsoon, which will last until the end of the month.
